Your provider will reach out to you to discuss your results in 2-3 weeks. In the event that you are found to be a carrier for a genetic condition, the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists recommends **partner carrier screening** be done to determine the best path forward for your preconception or pregnancy care.

If you and your partner are both carriers of the same recessive genetic condition, you have a 1 in 4 chance of having an affected child with that condition.
