### How does it work?

1



Your medical provider orders a test. We start processing your sample.

2



We generate an insurance estimate.

3



If we estimate your cost to exceed \$249,<sup>2</sup> we'll contact you and you choose how you pay: insurance or cash.

4



If you choose insurance, we'll send you a bill once your health plan confirms exactly how much you owe.

### How much will it cost?

#### If you choose insurance

Most patients receiving reproductive care meet their deductible. If you've met your deductible, the average out-of-pocket expense is **less than \$249.**<sup>1</sup> If you've not met your deductible, what you pay will go towards that amount, after which insurance begins to contribute to your care. If your insurance plan denies the claim, you will be eligible for our discounted cash price.

#### If you choose to pay cash

Some patients have high-deductible health plans. If we estimate your cost to exceed **\$249**<sup>2</sup> per test, we'll contact you to discuss cash pay options.

#### If you're experiencing financial hardship
