Making prenatal screening easy from the start

The California prenatal screening program (CA PNS) is transitioning to cell-free DNA (cfDNA) as the primary screening technology for trisomies 21, 18, and 13, as well as fetal sex (optional). This change in CA PNS technologies is intended to give patients access to high-quality noninvasive prenatal testing (NIPT) and more accurate results.
